

Collares neumáticos.

Los señores Sénéchal y Roy han ideado aplicar á los collares de los caballos tubos neumáticos análogos á los que se emplean en las llantas de las bicicletas y de los coches automóviles. La *Gazette Agricole* da cuenta de esta invención, y señala sus principales ventajas: 1.^a la gran ligereza en comparación de los collares de palastro, y sobre todo de los antiguos collares de cuero, que se usan todavía casi exclusivamente en el campo; 2.^a perfecta deformabilidad, que evita al caballo los dolores y heridas causadas por los collares ordinarios; 3.^a elasticidad del tubo neumático, que alivia sensiblemente los esfuerzos de tracción y permite, por consiguiente, imponer al caballo una carga más pesada.
